MAINE'S STRONG HISTORY

Maine's church, government, and collective people have a strong history of standing for those who are oppressed and need their voices to be heard. In the mid-1800s, Baptists, Methodists, Congregationalists, and other denominations across Maine preached against the wrongs of slavery and called Christians to stand against it.

Mainers opened their homes and churches as shelters to those fleeing slavery in the southern states. Maine had over seventy-five underground railroad locations. When the Civil War broke out, Mainers answered their call and sent the most troops per capita of any state to serve in the Union Army. Maine has a history of being a voice for the voiceless. If you look around the Maine Capitol today, you will see many tributes to these brave men and women who stood up against oppression and won. Maine must continue to be that beacon of light for all people, and just like it did in the mid-1800s, that beacon begins in Maine's churches.

GOD IS THE AUTHOR AND GIVER OF LIFE. HE DETERMINES WHEN LIFE BEGINS AND ENDS.


> "A thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I have come so that they may have life and have it in abundance." John 10:10

God values each life so much that He paid the ultimate price for us. As Christians, we can follow the example of our Savior by valuing all human lives.






EVERY ASPECT AND PART OF OUR LIFE MATTERS.
